Exodus 1:5-7 KJV

And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls: for Joseph was in Egypt already. [6] And Joseph died, and all his brethren, and all that generation. [7] And the children of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and waxed exceeding mighty; and the land was filled with them.

The book of Exodus introduces us to a new generation of Israelites. Some scholars believe that the time between Joseph to the time of Moses was approximately 294 years. In what was a short period of time, God was able to multiply the Israelites from a small group of 70 people to a great number that brought fear to a powerful nation like Egypt.



Exodus 1:8-10 KJV

Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, which knew not Joseph. [9] And he said unto his people, Behold, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we: [10] Come on, let us deal wisely with them; lest they multiply, and it come to pass, that, when there falleth out any war, they join also unto our enemies, and fight against us, and so get them up out of the land.

The children of Israel were mightier than the Egyptians; the Egyptians feared what the children of Israel could accomplish. Yet, it was the children of Israel who were in bondage. Fear led the king (Pharaoh) of Egypt to devise a plan to afflict the children of Israel, which resulted in their bondage.

Exodus 1:11-13 KJV

[11] Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses. [12] But the more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and grew. And they were grieved because of the children of Israel. [13] And the Egyptians made the children of Israel to serve with rigour:

Despite the attempt to control and prevent the growth of the children of Israel, their plan backfired. The more the children of Israel were afflicted, the more they multiplied. The more pain and suffering they endured, the greater their numbers became. Yet, despite all this, they remained captive, unable to shake off the mentality of captivity.

Their issue was not weakness or smallness; rather, it was a mindset that perceived themselves as small and weak.

You might reach a point in your life where you believe you cannot start a Bible study at your school, or you are incapable of reaching out to a friend about Jesus, or that your efforts to impact others would be futile because you feel insignificant.

Here's a verse to remember: 1 John 4:4

"YOU ARE OF GOD, LITTLE CHILDREN, AND HAVE OVERCOME THEM: BECAUSE GREATER IS HE THAT IS IN YOU, THAN HE THAT IS IN THE WORLD."
