PREPARE TO SPEAK UP!

1 Peter 3:15, "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear."

In a world that is outspoken about their opinions, feelings and their sinful lifestyle, it is such an important time for the children of God to be prepared to speak up more than ever before. More specifically, it is important to be bold and speak for ourselves. Just like prayer, our study of the scripture should not be reserved for services and when we are in church.
